## Why this category gets paid first

- Repetition is high and throughput matters every day.
- Labor pressure is persistent and easier to quantify.
- Operational wins can often be measured clearly.
- The wedge is narrow enough to deploy before trying to automate everything.

## What to watch

- Deployment density, not demo density.
- Integration and maintenance overhead.
- Payback period under operational stress.
- Whether the workflow is stable enough for automation.
